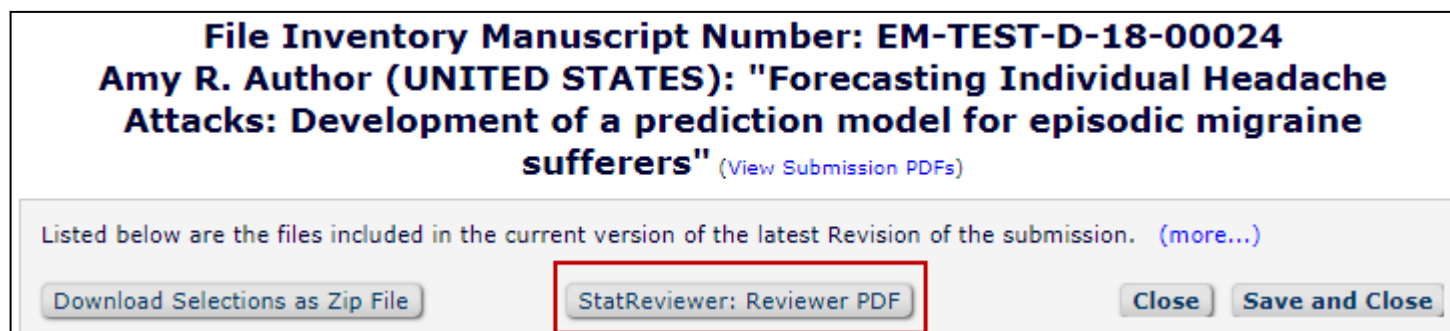
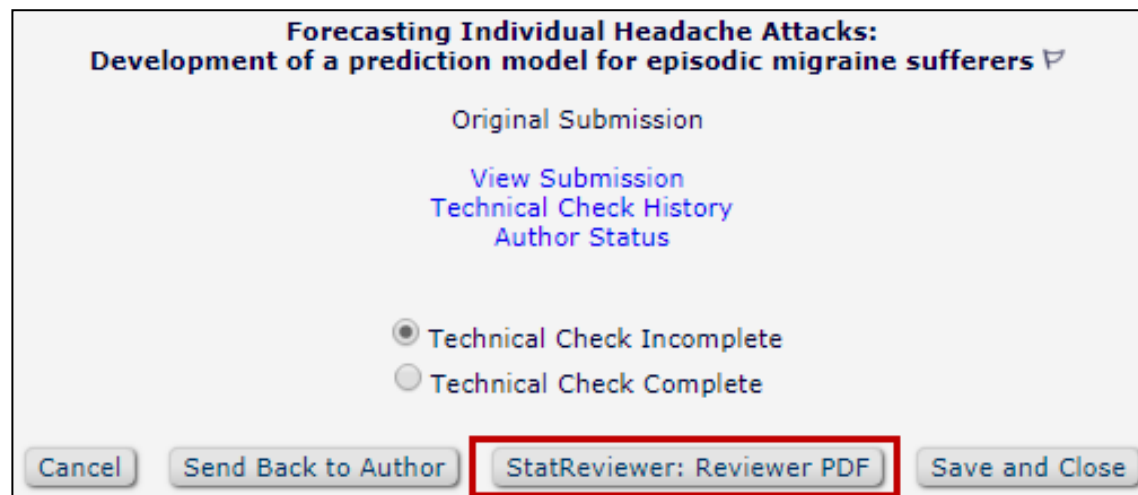

# Sending a submission to StatReviewer

- Can occur automatically at pre-defined workflow events
  - New Submission
  - Technical Check Completion
  - Editor Assignment
  - First Revision
- Can be done manually by Editors with “Initiate StatReviewer Analysis” permission
  - Technical Check
  - File Inventory

- Editors with “View StatReviewer Results” permission see a new “StatReviewer Results” link

## Title

**1** The subject of the study is very likely to be a keyword in a search engine. To make your study more relevant to your readers, include the subject of the research in the actual study title.

### More Information About This Issue

Most scientific topics cover a diverse set of subjects. Readers often wish to know if a particular study was done using animals or humans. Within human research participants, there is a vast array of subgroups such as age, racial, diagnostic, etc. To help your readers identify the relevance of your study to their interests it is helpful to report the research subject(s) directly in the title.

### Examples

This title: "Tumor size and lymph node status on survival"  
Can be revised to this: "Tumor size and lymph node status on 5-year survival in women with breast cancer"

## Methods

**2** Although stating that "written consent" was obtained from human participants, proper consent should also be "informed" (i.e., through a process of enhanced understanding about the nature of the research). Thus, describing this process as "written informed consent" is recommended.

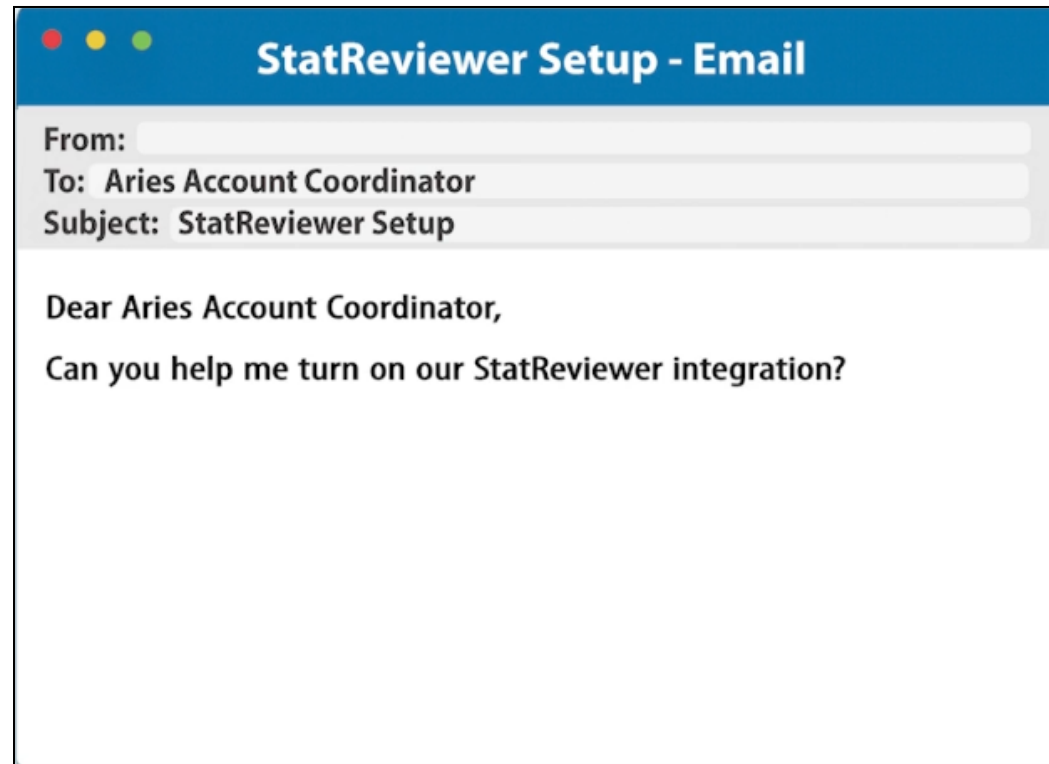

## 4. Policy Manager > Edit Article Types:

Configure Automatic Triggers for StatReviewer Analysis

- Workflow events can automatically send submission to StatReviewer
- Configured by Article Type

### StatReviewer Analysis:

- Send Reviewer PDF when Transfer Complete link is clicked
- Send Reviewer PDF when New Submission Received
- Send Reviewer PDF on Tech Check Completion
- Send Reviewer PDF at First Editor Assignment
- Send Reviewer PDF at First Revision
