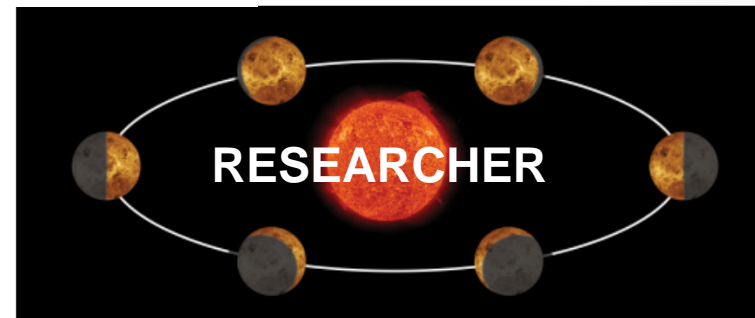
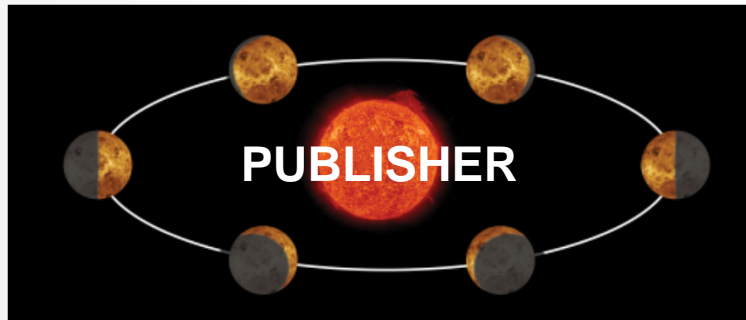

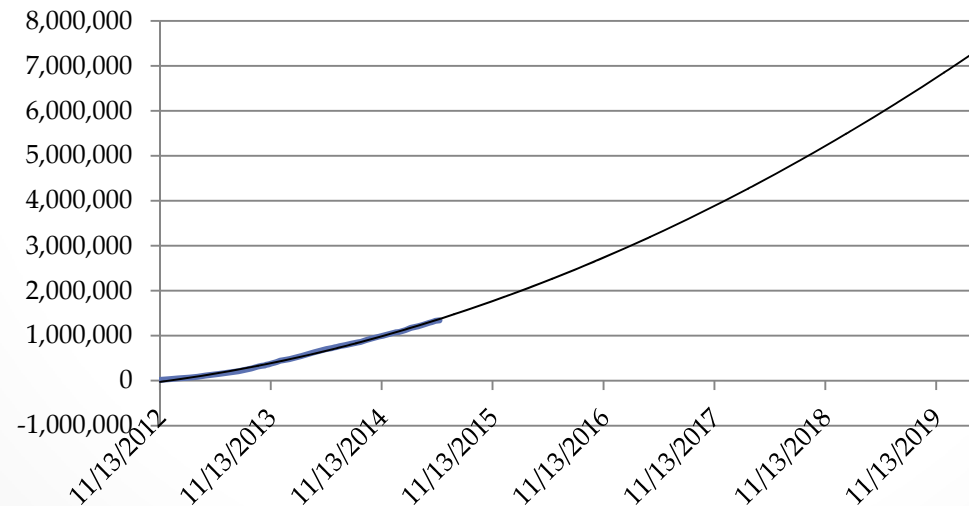


# ORCID



- 7.5 million IDs
- ORCID Single Sign-On will be industry standard

# XML

- Automated XML creation
- Full XML-first workflow, including editing
- JATS everywhere
- Authoring becomes interactively collaborative for 25% of manuscripts
- Microsoft Word as authoring tool declines



# Peer Review

- Basic model unchanged
- Reviews available as part of the publication record
- Review activity documented
- Interactive discussion between editors, reviewers and authors becomes common



# Open Access

- 20%-30% of all published articles
- Average APC fee under \$1,000
- 30%-40% of articles from Asia/India



# Print & Publication

- 50% of titles will be e-only
- 95% of new titles will be e-only
- Number of new titles will increase rapidly, reflecting lowered cost of e-only processing and publication
- Average time to publication approaches 30 days – accelerating science





# Mega Journals

- Constrained by number of major publishers
- Major publishers will all have robust offerings
- Cascade/transfer of manuscripts will increase publishers' "yield"
