



Creating an Editor Chain

For New or Revised Submissions

Sample Peer Review Workflow



- Peer Review workflow is based on the assumption that one Editor assigns the submission on to another Editor
- Each Editor in turn may assign the submission on to another Editor
- In this way, the individual Editors create a 'Decision Chain' (Editor Assignment Chain) through a series of discrete assignments
- Once Editors start to submit recommendations the submission returns up the chain that was built incrementally


While proxied in as the first assigned Editor, the Editorial Office searches for and selects an Editor. . .



The Editorial Office invites the next Editor – and then starts all over again to build the complete Editor Assignment Chain.

What's the Problem?

 Most publications use the same sequence of Editor Assignments to create an Editor Chain each time they process a submission



- Some publications rely on the Editorial Office to create the Chain to reduce the Editors' workload
- This means that the EO must proxy in for each Editor in turn in order to build the complete Editor Chain
- What a tedious process!



What if?

- The Editor Assignment Chain could be *created* in one action on a single page?
- Publications could create various templates that could then be associated with different Article Types and then use that template to assign specific Editors?
- A template could be created to preselect an Editor Role and default assignment letter for each step of the Chain?
- Revisions could be assigned using a template?


A new 'Assign Editor Chain' Feature is available in V. 12.1!



- New 'Assign Editor Chain' functionality is coming in EM v.
 12.1
- System Administrators can create 'Assignment Chain Templates' in PolicyManager
- Templates can then be associated with individual Article Types
- When the EO clicks the <u>Assign Editor</u> link a new page is displayed showing the suggested Editor Roles and Assignment Letters
- The EO can select specific Editors, add or remove steps and customize Assignment Letters



The Editorial Office clicks the <u>Assign Editor</u> Action Link, as in current functionality.




- The new Assign Editor Chain page is displayed based on the template associated with the submission's Article Type
- Each step is associated with a suggested Editor Role
- The Role determines how the Editors to be assigned are identified:
 - A combo box allows users to select from Editors in a dropdown list
 - The <u>Editor Search</u> link brings the user to a search interface
- The template's default Assignment Letter is displayed







The mechanism used to identify the appropriate Editor for the assignment is defined by the Editor Role.



The Role for the step in the Chain is preselected but can be changed on the *Assign Editor Chain: Search* page.



When the Editor to be assigned is selected, the user clicks the 'Assign Selected Editor' button.




The selected Editor is now displayed for the step in the Editor Assignment Chain, and the assigning Editor can click <u>Customize</u> to personalize the letter.









Additional 'Editor Steps' can be added to the Chain by selecting a Role and clicking the 'Add to Chain' button.




If the proposed Editor or Role is invalid, an error icon ▲ is displayed and the 'Create Chain and Send Letters' button is disabled.




Informational text is displayed when the user hovers over the error icon. In this example, the Role selected for Editor 3 does not have RoleManager permission to assign other Editors, and must be the last Editor in the Chain.



If the logged-in user prefers, he or she can click the 'Assign Individual Editor' button to assign only the first Editor, instead of assigning the entire Chain.



After clicking the 'Assign Individual Editor' button, the user is prompted to select the first assigned Editor.



After clicking the 'Assign Individual Editor' button, the 'Assign Editor' page displays Editors with permission to receive assignments – not just Editors with a particular Role.








The 'Assign Editor Chain' page does not allow an individual Editor to be assigned to more than one step in the Chain.




If only one registered user has the selected Editor Role, his or her name is displayed as plain text in the 'Editor' column.



Set Editor Assignment Options

New Submissions

The settings below control how new manuscripts are assigned to Editors. The first choice, 'Submissions go to New Submissions Requiring Assignment folder' allows manual assignment of editors. The sub option "Submissions where Author has Selected an Editor" automatically directs the submission to the Editor selected by the Author at the 'Request Editor' manuscript submission step. The sub option 'Submissions where Author has Selected a Section/Category' automatically directs the submission to the Editor selected by the Author at the 'Select Section/Category' manuscript submission step.

If "Assign to Editors by Rotation" is selected, the submissions are automatically directed to the Editor with the oldest assignment date.



Modifying an Editor Chain

Replace or Remove an Editor

- Editors with permission can click the <u>Unassign Editor</u>
 Action Link to 'Unassign' or 'Switch' the assignment for the *lowest level Editor* in the Chain
- The lowest level Editor must not have saved or submitted an Editorial decision
- If the Editor is removed from the Chain, Reviewers are associated with the next highest Editor in the Chain
- If the assignment is switched to another Editor, reviews are associated with the new Editor
- Editors with 'Unassign Other Editors' and 'Assign Editor' permission can remove or replace the Editor at the *bottom of the Chain*
- Editors with 'Unassign Myself' and 'Assign Editor' permission – who are at the bottom of the Chain – can remove or replace their own assignment

If the current Editor Assignment Chain is:



Editor C can be removed from the Chain




or Editor C's assignment can be switched to another Editor.



If there is only one Editor in the Chain, and Reviewers *have not been* invited, the assignment can be rolled back.



If there is only one Editor in the Chain, and Reviewers *have bee*n invited the assignment can only be switched to another Editor.



If Reviewers have been invited or assigned:



Editor C's assignment can be switched to another Editor:



Or the assignment can be rolled back:



But no other Editors can be added to the Chain once the assignment has rolled back if Reviewers have been invited or assigned!

What if?

- The Editor Assignment Chain could be modified in one action on a single page?
- An Editor with permission could replace or remove an Editor for any step in the Editor Assignment Chain – not just the lowest level Editor?
- Editors could be replaced after they have submitted a decision?
- An Editor with permission could replace or remove multiple Editors in one action, on a single page?
- An Editor with permission could replace one Editor with another Editor who has a *different* Editor Role?

In EM v. 12.2, Editors can replace or remove an Editor from any step in the Editor Assignment Chain:




- An Editor who has saved or submitted a decision can be replaced by another Editor with the *same Role*
- Under certain conditions, an Editor may be replaced by another Editor with a different Role
- Replacement Editors inherit the history of the Editor they have replaced
- Under certain conditions, an Editor may be removed from the Chain altogether
- Default or customized letters may be sent
- Modifications to the Editor Chain are visible on the Custom *Details* page, the *History* page and in Reports

The <u>Unassign Editor</u> link is displayed for Editors with access to the submission and permission to modify the Chain, up to the point that the Final Disposition is set for the submission. Clicking the link brings the user to the new *Modify Editor Chain* page.



In this example, the logged-in Editor is either not in the Chain AND has permission to remove / replace other Editors OR is the first Editor in the Chain and has permission to remove or replace her assignment or that of subordinate Editors.




In this example, Michael Editor is the logged-in Editor, has not saved or submitted a decision and has permission to remove or replace his own Editor assignment.






The 'New Editor' column displays non-blinded Editors with the Role selected in the 'Role' column – either in a dropdown list or in the search results.






When the Role selected in the 'Role' column is changed, only non-blinded Editors with the selected Role are displayed in the 'New Editor' dropdown list or search results.




When searching for an Editor, the Role name is preselected on the search page.




Editors who have submitted a decision cannot be removed – they can only be replaced by another Editor who has the *same* Role.




In this example, the logged-in user has permission to unassign other Editors, but does not have permission to replace Editors in the Chain. Since all Editors have submitted decisions they cannot be removed.




In this example, Sally Editor is the only user with a "Managing Editor" Role. Text is displayed that reads, "No available users have this Role".




Once Editors have made a decision, their assignment can be switched to another Editor with the *same* Editor Role, but they cannot be removed from the Editor Assignment Chain.



If Reviewers have been invited or assigned, the only Editor in the Chain can be replaced but not removed. Someone has to handle the incoming reviews!



When the proposed changes are valid, the 'Confirm Selections and Send Default Letters' and 'Confirm Selections and Send Custom Letters' buttons are enabled.



Letters can be customized for those recipients whose Role is configured to receive notifications for these events in ActionManager.





Modify Editor Chain (v. 12.2)

- The Editor Assignment Chain can be *modified* in one action on a single page
- Editors with permission can remove or replace an Editor for any step in the Chain (subject to conditions)
- Editors can be replaced after submitting a decision, until the Final Disposition is set
- Editors can be replaced by another Editor with a different Role (subject to conditions)
