What is *EM for Books*?

- Combination of overlapping editorial workflow (Editorial Manager) and production workflow (ProduXion Manager) functionality
- Provides
 - ✓ Configurable workflows: roles, files, forms, letters, etc.
 - ✓ Metadata and files
 - ✓ Configurable tasks
 - ✓ Automated reminders, tracking, etc.
 - ✓ Reporting

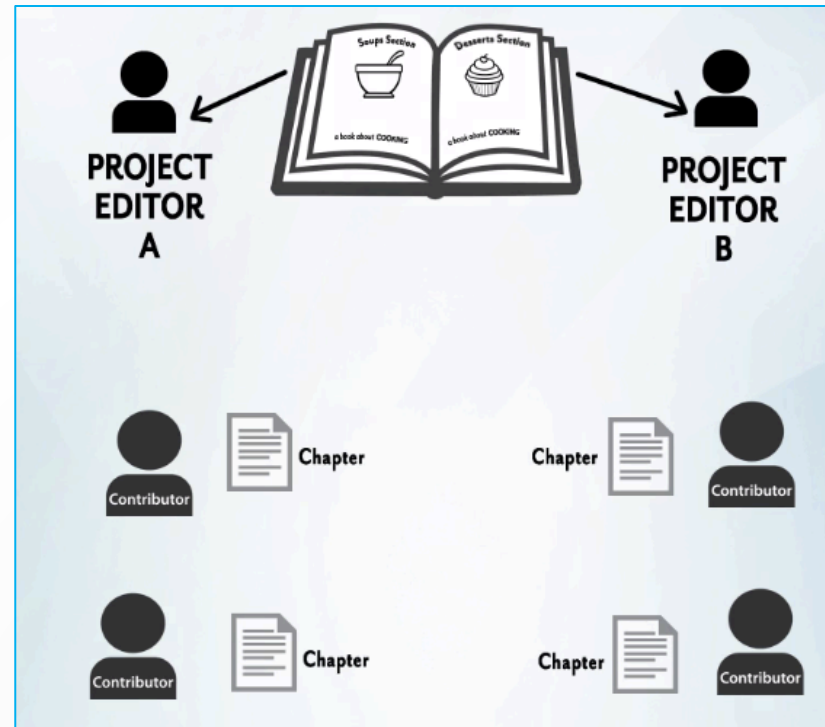


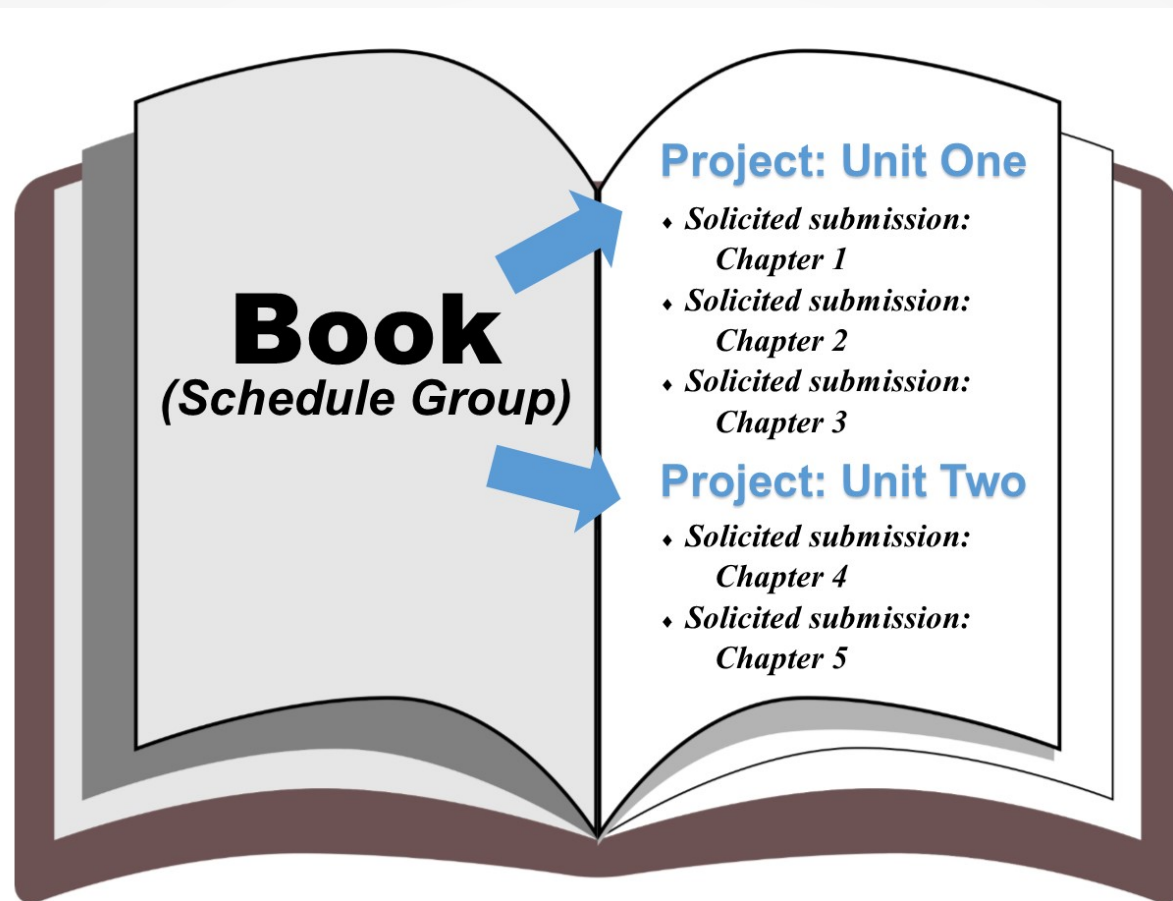
What is *EM for Books*?

- Text throughout the system has been updated to use a book-related vocabulary
- Books-focused features
 - ✓ Enhancements to existing features were rolled out in 13.0, 13.1
 - ✓ Additional functionality is planned for 14.0
 - ✓ Future development will refine workflow based on feedback and user interface
- Using a dedicated EM/PM site for book processing is recommended

What is **EM** *for Books*?

Data model is appropriate for multiple types of books: books, sections, chapters, contributions





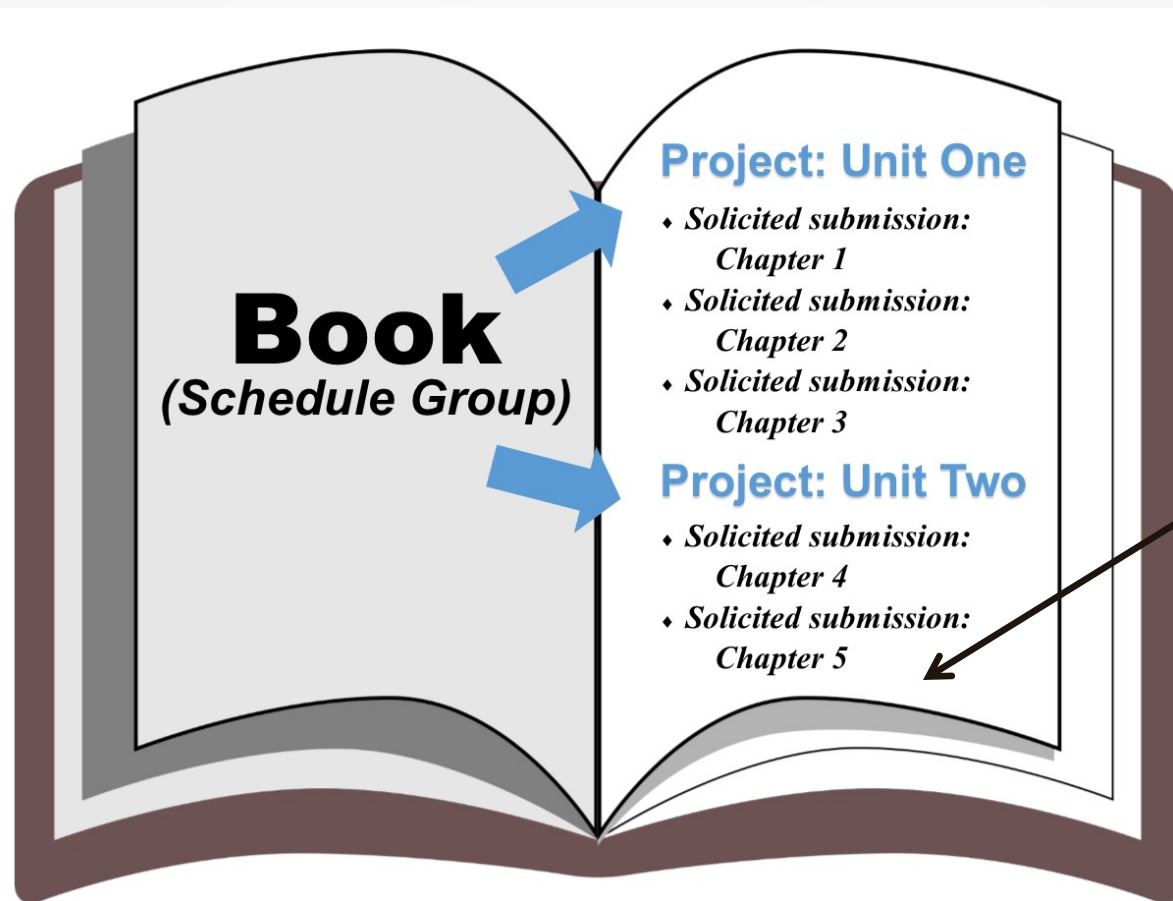

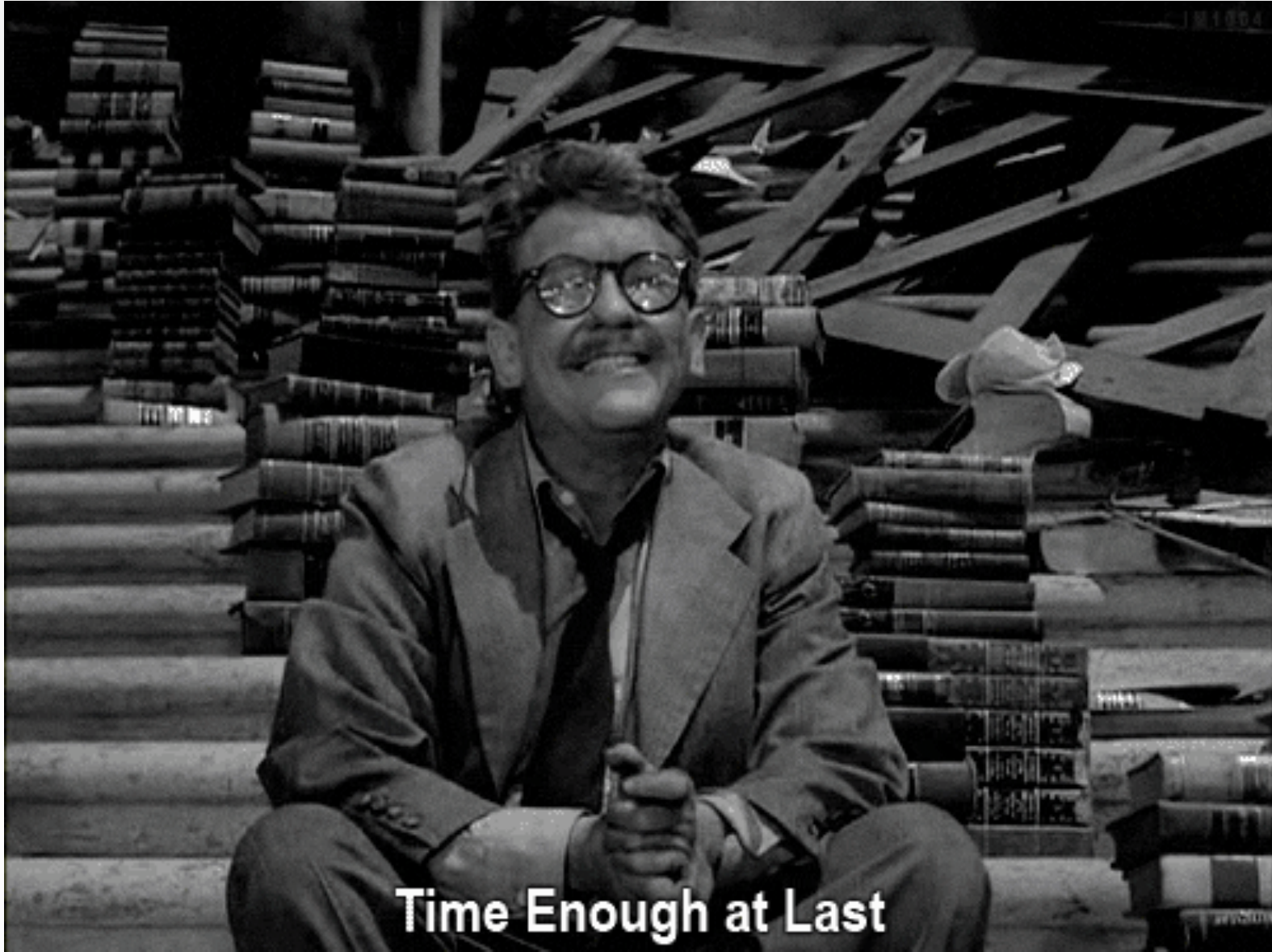


Adapting EM for Book Publishing

Once upon a time...

Once upon a time...

- To achieve the desired books workflow, existing EM/PM functionality was reviewed and evaluated
- Key features were already in place:
 - ✓ Preselected Article Types for invited workflow
 - ✓ Proposals being linked to multiple solicited submissions
 - ✓ The ability to construct a table of contents using a Schedule Group



Time Enough at Last

Books Feature Development

- Existing features
 - ✓ Schedule Group enhancements (book families, metadata fields)
 - ✓ Proposal and invited submission enhancements
 - ✓ Ability to upload Author/Contributor list file
 - ✓ Predefine invited article titles
 - ✓ Assign Author/Contributor
 - ✓ Manuscript numbering enhancements
 - ✓ Books language pack

Books Feature Development

- Coming soon
 - ✓ BITS Production Task Transmittals
 - ✓ Additional Schedule Group/Book Detail Fields

Books Language Pack

New “language pack” specific to books

- Terminology selected based on feedback from key users

Examples:

- ✓ “Schedule Group” → “**Book**”
 - ✓ “Proposal” → “**Project**”
 - ✓ “Author” → “**Contributor**”
 - ✓ “Article Type” → “**Manuscript Type**”
- Intended to be site-wide conversion for sites dedicated to a book publishing workflow

Default Books Template

- We've created a separate template used to create new books sites on EM
- The template is configured with book-related features enabled, allowing for quick setup of a new site for dedicated books processing

 - Issue in a journal workflow
 - Book in a books workflow
- ✓ Provides top level metadata, table of contents
- Schedule Groups enhanced with Issue and Book “families”
 - ✓ Book family has new metadata fields specific to books (e.g., book title, multiple ISBNs, edition)
 - ✓ Book site can be configured to automatically create new Schedule Groups in the Book family
- Books language pack renames “Schedule Group” to “Book”

Proposal/Project Enhancements

- Proposals are called “Projects” in the Books language pack
- Project Article Types can be designated as book-related
- If a Project is book-related, it can be associated with a Book when the Project is initiated
 - ✓ Projects are shown as headers in the Book TOC
 - ✓ Subsequent chapters/invited submissions solicited for this project are tied to Book

Proposal/Project Enhancements

Editor chooses an existing Book from the drop-down menu (or creates a new one) when initiating Project

Initiate Project

Selecting a Book is required. Once a Book has been selected, information from that Book will be displayed automatically, and Project creation can continue. A Book can be added to the list by clicking the 'Add Book' link.

Invited Submission Enhancements

- Book-related metadata fields are also available for invited submissions
- When a Project is assigned to a Book, the invited submissions from this Project will also be pre-assigned to the Book
 - ✓ Assignment occurs when a submission is received by publication
 - ✓ Assigned manuscripts appear in new “Pre-selected Submissions” grid on *Book Details* pages
 - ✓ Added to TOC when submissions enter production

- Invited-workflow enhancement allows Contributors to receive assignments directly, instead of receiving invitations
- Enables workflows in which a Contributor can submit a solicited chapter without first having to accept an invitation
- New ActionManager events support separate default Contributor assignment letter templates for Commentaries and Submissions invited for a Project



Assign Contributor

- Properly permissioned Editors will have access to an “assign” option when selecting Contributors
 - ✓ Configurations allow Editors to access either “invite” or “assign” option, or both
- Compatible with Contributor List File upload process
 - ✓ Contributor List File can contain a mix of Contributors selected for invitation or assignment
- Contributor assignments go directly to the *My Assignments* folder on the Contributor Main Menu

Upload Contributor List File

- EM allows Editors to upload a list of Contributors to solicit, instead of searching for each individually
- Ideal for a Book or Project where multiple assignments will be handled by a large, known list of Contributors

Upload Contributor List File

- Invitation column controls whether Contributors will be invited or assigned directly
 - ✓ Set to *True* to auto-select Contributor for invitation
 - ✓ Set to *False* to auto-select Contributor for assignment
 - ✓ Provide no value to select the Contributor without an invite/assign option selected

Contributor Candidate Confirmation

- EM finds matching user account (ORCID, email address, names)
- New Contributor is proxy registered if no account is found
- Contributors can be invited for multiple submissions/chapters

Manuscript Numbering Enhancements

- Projects are tracked in EM using the Project manuscript number
- Invited submissions are tracked using their individual manuscript numbers
- Enhanced automated manuscript numbering functionality creates a clear link between the Project and submission, as well as between the related submissions
- Format for invited submission manuscript numbers is configured as part of the Project Manuscript Type settings

Manuscript Numbering Enhancements

When initiating a Project, Editors will set numbering format, which is applied to all the invited submissions

Manuscript Numbering Enhancements

Editors can preview the invited submission manuscript number format before finalizing the Project

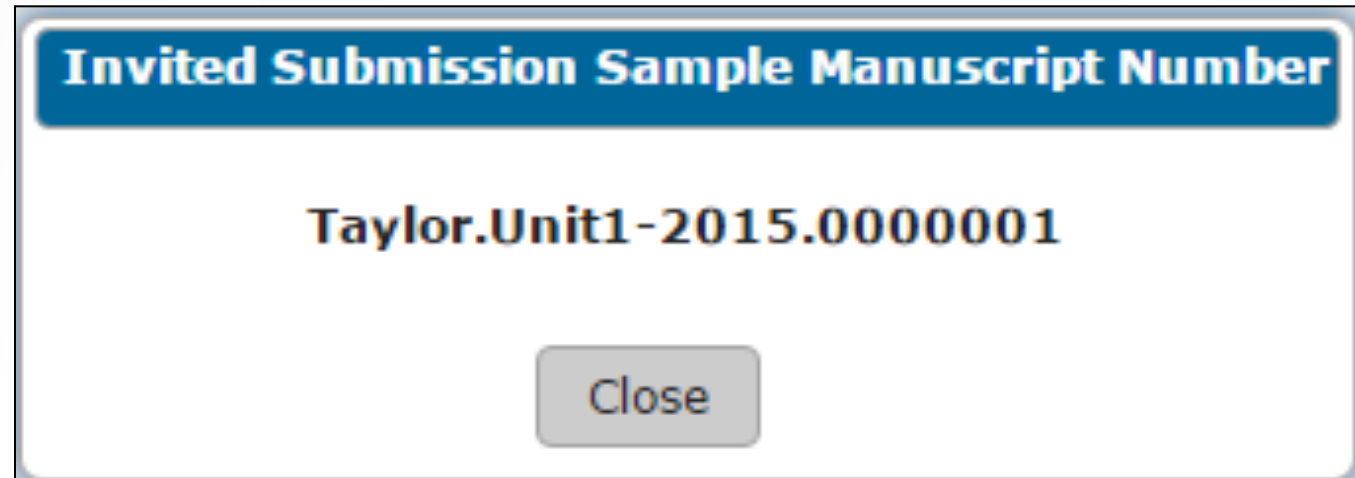
Example:

- Prefix = Taylor.Unit1-2015.
- Starting Number = 1
- Minimum Number of Digits in Starting Number = 7

Manuscript Numbering Enhancements

Result:

- First invited submission will have the number
Taylor.Unit1-2015.0000001
- Second invited submission will have the number
Taylor.Unit1-2015.0000002
- And so on
