Example 1:

Sulfate is an important anion in biological system s. We have shown for the first time that small molecules can bind to sulfate and allow it to diffuse across lipid bilayer membranes. This was previously thought impossible as sulfate is very strongly bound to water. We have used 33S NMR experiments to confirm sulfate transport.

Example 2:

Open Source Software (OSS) development and Human Computer Interaction (HCI) work have established their positions, but do they actually fit together? This paper examines if there is any hope of bringing HCI work into OSS context and if OSS and HCI philosophies can exist in the same project.
